



Dear Colleague,

We are pleased to invite you to participate in the 2019 Orthodontic Module for Certified Dental Assistants and Registered Dental Hygienists. There is a long waitlist for this course and there are only 80 spaces available. As such, early registration is recommended. The 2019 Orthodontic Module sessions are scheduled as follows:

Wednesday May 22 (full day) Thursday May 23 (full day) Friday May 24 (full day)	Lecture Sessions	All participants must attend 80 participants
Saturday May 25 – Wednesday May 29	Clinical Session A	40 participants
Saturday June 8 – Wednesday June 12	Clinical Session B	40 participants

The course fee is \$1495.00. You may pay in full upon registration or by instalments, or you can pay in instalments as follows, \$295 deposit due immediately upon registration, \$600 due on February 1st, 2019 and \$600 due on April 9th, 2019. As this is a limited enrollment course, your registration is your commitment to participate. The deposit of \$295 is non refundable at any time. There will be no refund of any monies paid after February 1st, 2019 for any reason and payments are not transferable to other persons or years.

Please note that there are two ways to register:

Please note that we will only have a Session B if we have enough demand for two sessions.

Once you have registered we will send you a receipt of registration by email. Your information booklet/study guide will be sent to you in mid April and it will confirm the exact dates that you will be in your clinical session.

Please note that participants will work intraorally on each other in this course.

The University of British Columbia has been offering the Orthodontic Module since 1979, and the team of instructors is very committed to making this a valuable and successful learning experience. As the clinical portion of this course can be difficult for participants, it is a pre-requisite that those attending have a minimum of ONE year of clinical experience in a dental practice. Some exceptions are made but must be pre-cleared by our office. Other pre-requisites include: you must hold a valid BC license; you must have good vision or wear corrective lenses; if in braces you will need to remove some brackets/wires, or provide a stand-in; you must have enough teeth that can be separated, or provide a stand-in.

With over 200 participants on our waitlist, early registration is recommended.
