2019 Orthodontic Module UPDATE for Certified Dental Assistants and Registered Dental Hygienists

COURSE DESCRIPTION

We are pleased to invite you to participate in the Orthodontic Module Update 2019 for Certified Dental Assistants and Registered Dental Hygienists. This is a three day lecture program hosted by Continuing Dental Education at the University of British Columbia and presented by Dr. Paul Witt, who has been teaching the Orthodontic Module at UBC since 1981.

Like all professions, orthodontic practices and procedures have changed and evolved over the years. Depending upon your experiences in practice since you participated in an Orthodontic Module, your understanding of orthodontic techniques and procedures may not be current. This program will provide you with an up-to-date knowledge base.

The Update is open to CDAs and RDHs who have already completed an accredited Orthodontic Module. You can take this course regardless of whether or not you are currently licensed to practice, or employed. This course is not applicable to participants who are required by the College of Dental Surgeons of BC to be recertified in Orthodontics.

The program will run Wednesday May 22nd – Friday May 24th inclusive from 8:30am – 5:30pm (approx.). Participants in the Module Update will attend the same lecture sessions as the participants in the UBC Orthodontic Module 2019 Licensing Program, but will not attend the clinical component of the Program. As such, there is no examination or clinical evaluation for participants in the Module Update. The lectures will be held in the Woodward IRC building on the UBC Vancouver Point Grey campus (a map will be sent to you in advance of the course).

The cost of the Update course is \$495 per person and includes an Orthodontic Module Manual and extensive Lecture Notes. If time permits, we will send your manual to you in advance of the course. If you register within 10 days of the first day of the course, you will receive your manual on site.

CLINICIAN:

Paul A. Witt, DDS, Dip Ortho, FRCD(C), graduated in Dentistry from the University of Toronto in 1974 and received a Diploma in Orthodontics in 1979, also from the University of Toronto. Dr. Witt has been teaching orthodontics since 1981 and is currently a Clinical Assistant Professor with the Graduate Orthodontics Program in the Faculty of Dentistry at the University of British Columbia.
