We are pleased to invite you to participate in the 2020 Orthodontic Module for Certified Dental Assistants and Registered Dental Hygienists. There is a long waitlist for this course and there are only 80 spaces available. As such, early registration is recommended. The 2020 Orthodontic Module sessions are scheduled as follows:

The course fee is \$1495.00. You may pay in full upon registration or by instalments as follows, \$795 deposit due immediately upon registration, \$700 due on April 8th, 2020. As this is a limited enrollment course, your registration is your commitment to participate. \$295 of the fees are non refundable at any time. There will be no refund of any monies paid after February 1st, 2020 for any reason and payments are not transferable to other persons or years.

Once you have registered we will send you a receipt of registration by email. Your information booklet/study guide will be sent to you in mid April and it will confirm the exact dates that you will be in your clinical session.

Please note that participants will work intraorally on each other in this course.

The University of British Columbia has been offering the Orthodontic Module since 1979, and the team of instructors is very committed to making this a valuable and successful learning experience. As the clinical portion of this course can be difficult for participants, it is a pre-requisite that those attending have a minimum of **ONE year of clinical experience in a dental practice**. Some exceptions are made but must be pre-approved by our office. Other pre-requisites include: you must hold a valid BC license; you must have good vision or wear corrective lenses; if in braces you will need to remove some brackets/wires, or provide a stand-in; you must have enough teeth that can be separated, or provide a stand-in. You will be required to sign a consent form for your partner to perform orthodontic training procedures, or in the case of a stand-in, for your stand-in to consent

With over 300 participants on our waitlist, early registration is recommended.
